

REQUIREMENTS FOR BOARDING

1. All cats must have a current physical exam with a Cat Care veterinarian prior to boarding.
 - a. Cats less than 10 years old, need to be current within the last year.*
 - b. Cats over 10 years old, need to be current within the last 6 months.*
2. All cats must be current on rabies and upper respiratory (FVRCP) vaccines.*
3. All cats must be free of external parasites (fleas, ticks) or Cat Care will treat them on entry for a fee.

We can arrange an appointment for services preferably prior to boarding (or during boarding stay.)

4. If food is arriving without original packaging, all food must be labeled properly with brand of food, special diet, etc.
5. All medications must be in the original prescription container.
6. Make sure all personal items are labeled with your cat's name.
7. Boarding drop off and pick-up times are between 8:30am to 4:30pm, Monday through Friday, and 9am to 11:30am on Saturdays.
 - a. If you require a drop off or pick up outside of the provided times, there will be an early/late fee please ask for the current price.

We are closed to the public on Sundays.

8. If your cat were to fall ill, we would try to contact you with the information provided. If your cat requires medical attention and we cannot contact you, it will be provided by Cat Care, or a local emergency facility if our Cat Care veterinarian is not available. *Fees will be assessed.*
9. All of these requirements are to protect the health of your cat and provide the clearest communication between our staff and our clients.
